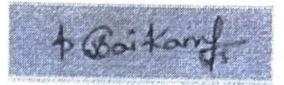

INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

1. An electronic copy of the Admit Card is NOT acceptable. 2. To facilitate the identity verification by the Examination Centre personnel, candidates are advised to report to the examination venue at least 90 minutes before the scheduled commencement of the examination. Candidates will NOT BE ALLOWED to login 30 minutes after the start of the exam.
3. Candidates will be permitted to occupy their seats before the scheduled start of the examination. Candidates can login and start reading the instructions 20 minutes before the start of the examination.
4. During the examination, a virtual scientific calculator will be available on the candidate's computer.
5. Personal calculators, mobile phones, watches of any kind or any other electronic devices are prohibited inside the Examination Centre. Charts, tables, papers, books, sheets and heavy ornaments are also not allowed inside the Test Centre.
6. A scribble pad will be provided for rough work. Candidates must write their name and Registration number on the scribble pad before using it. A candidate can possess only one scribble pad at any point of time. If the scribble pad gets filled, candidates can ask for another scribble pad, after returning the previous one to the invigilator. A scribble pad once surrendered will not be returned to the candidate. At the end of the examination, the scribble pad in possession of the candidate must be returned to the invigilator.



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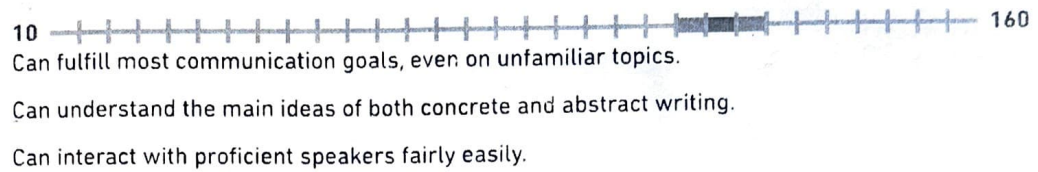

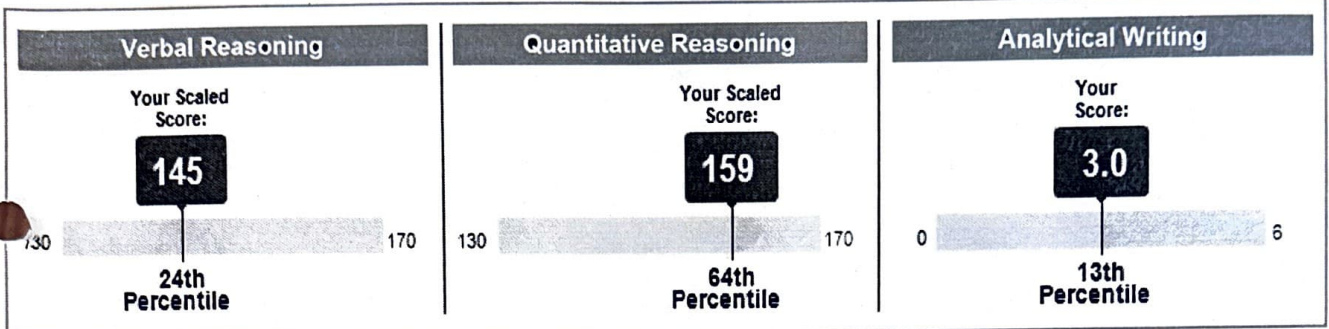

They can identify ideas, attitudes, opinions or purposes which are implied by the speaker but not directly stated. They can easily understand meaning, including references within and between sentences, without having to process individual words and structures. They can understand a wide range of vocabulary, including some idiomatic, technical, and academic language, even when the language and ideas are complex.

Listen to current affairs and documentary programmes, or online talks, without pausing or repeating the recording. Try to remember as much as you can, including new words, main ideas, specific points, and their relationship to each other. Afterward, reconstruct what you've heard. How much are you able to reconstruct? Listen more and try to increase the amount that you can reconstruct. When speakers don't directly say what they mean, we use strategies to guess their meaning. What are some of these strategies that you use in your own language? Use the same strategies to understand them in English.

Reading 7.0

Test takers at Band 7 can typically deal with a variety of factual and opinion-based texts that may be complex and dense with information. They are very good at using their wide vocabulary knowledge to create meaning, both within and across sentences, on a range of general and specialised topics. They can follow an argument and distinguish between main ideas and supporting details, and are good at understanding attitude, opinion and implication. They are able to do this by using reading strategies such as skimming and scanning, and by synthesizing information and drawing inferences.

At this level, it is important to broaden the range of texts you read further. Continue to develop your awareness of how to read different types of texts differently. What features does that particular type of text typically have? How is information structured and arranged in such texts? Will it require making inferences? Will there be a summary somewhere? Use your knowledge of these and approach the reading task in an appropriate way. Where you want to know the overall argument or specific arguments, try to do this as efficiently as possible. As an exercise, try to find several opinion-based texts on the internet, and then determine the similarities and differences in their opinions and views.

Speaking 6.5

Test takers at this band can typically speak at length, although they are sometimes less clear or fluent because of repetition, self-correction, or hesitation to search for words or grammar. Speaking is generally well-organised, and ideas are generally well linked, but with some errors. They have enough vocabulary to discuss topics clearly and at length, although there are often errors, and they can usually paraphrase well. They can use simple and complex grammar structures but with limited range. There may be frequent grammar errors, particularly in more

Talk to other English speakers about more abstract topics or more difficult current topics. Keep the discussion going for as long as possible. At the same time, try to express your ideas as accurately as you can, using the best words you know. Many of your ideas will also require the use of complex grammatical structures. If you're using several simple sentences, try to join them up in a way that makes your point clearer. Listen (and read) in English more to help you pick up natural and

complex structures, but language is usually easy to understand. Pronunciation can be clear and effective, but there may be problems. They are usually easy to understand, although words may be unclear at times.

They can flexibly use a range of vocabulary and some less common words with some style, despite occasionally choosing the wrong word or making mistakes in spelling or in the form of a word. They are able to use a variety of complex sentences, and many of their sentences are correct. However they still make a few mistakes with grammar and punctuation.

For words and phrases that are newer to you, look them up online to see how other writers use them and what other words they often appear together with. Finally, check your writing, paying special attention to those words and grammar structures you're not as confident about.
